Complainant Statement

Jessica and I used to be friends because we hang around the same group and she lives in Trever with me. Last month, her boyfriend Jack broke up with her to date me. Ever since then, she's been sending me messages online and through Facebook saying that I messed up her life and that now she's going to mess up mine. I told her to back off and leave me alone.
