The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the results of your Judicial Board hearing on February 9, 2021. The Judicial Board has found you in violation of the following:

COVID 19 RESIDENTIAL POLICIES & EXPECTATIONS

Lawrence University Community Pledge

- Maintain at least 6 feet of physical distance from others in accordance with university guidelines.

Lawrence Residential Policies & Expectations

- Student room capacity for gatherings will be restricted to the number of room occupants plus one (ex. Double rooms will allow for a maximum of three people at any time).

Residential warning through March 17, 2021, which constitutes notification that further incidents or violations of the Social Code and/or COVID policies and protocols will be brought back to this Board for consideration and adjudication and may result in expulsion from the residence in which you are living or from campus housing altogether.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you must inform the President, in writing, within three days of receiving this letter.

The members of the Board hope you understand that our responsibility is to hear all formal complaints, decide if a violation has been committed and apply a sanction when warranted. We hope you understand that you need to respect the rights of others if we are to maintain a satisfactory living and learning environment at Lawrence. The college community must insist upon the cooperation and responsible judgment of all students.
